

ROSSA DI TREVISO PRECOCE - TREVOR

Plants are compact and vigorous, producing good sized heads **weighing 300-350 g**. Leaves have a thick, broad, white stem with a bright red border. The cycle is **medium-early, ripening 90 day** after planting. It is recommended for spring and autumn harvest.
